It may be a short week, but we are going to pack in lots of great learning!

In our **Word of God** we are looking closely at the Parable of the Good Samaritan and the Parable of the Unforgiving Servant. Both of these parables are lessons Jesus taught about how we ought to show love for others around us. In the first parable, Jesus taught that as Christians we want to

show God's love to all of the people around us - friends, family, strangers, and even enemies. In the second parable Jesus reminds us how important it is to forgive others just as God has forgiven us. May God help us to show love and forgiveness to those around us!

The **January Memory Work** calendar is coming home today. Please make sure to practice these passages with your child at home, so when they come to school they are able to say the passage or verse easily to me.
