This week in Christ-light we are going to be learning about God's mercy and forgiveness. Our first lesson is about the Pharisee and Tax Collector. Jesus told this parable about these two opposite men and explained that the Tax Collector, a man who was so despised by his peers as being a horrible sinner, was forgiven for his sins, while the Pharisee was not. Their biggest difference was inside them. In his mind the Pharisee had no need for a Savior, while the Tax Collector confessed his sin and pleaded for mercy. The

second lesson we are learning this week is the Parable of the Lost Son. When I was growing up, I knew this as the "Parable of the Prodigal Son." Jesus told this parable to explain our Heavenly Father's love for us. We are the rebellious sons who go off on our own. Our Forgiving Father searches for us, welcomes us home when we repent, and gives us the free and full forgiveness earned for us by our Savior. What amazing grace he showers on us!
