

What Wild Things Are Going on in K and 1? 12/9/24

It's all about trust this week. In both of our Word of God lessons we learn how Jesus taught his disciples (and us!) to trust in him to take care of all their needs. Our first lesson is Jesus Feeds the Five Thousand. In the lesson Jesus challenges the disciples to provide enough food for the large crowd. While the disciples recognized that they did not have the resources to feed all the people, they didn't see that the one who provides for all our needs was right in front of them.

How often this happens to us, too! We worry about all kinds of things, fretting and losing sleep, while the solution to all our problems is right here! Let's take this lesson to heart and recognize that our Savior Jesus will provide for all our needs.

In Kindergarten reading we are continuing to learn about the letter Ii and Superkid Icky. By the end of the week we will start our new unit about three Superkids who are best friends: Tic, Tac, and Toc. These three girls call themselves "Triple Trouble" because they love playing together, being loud, silly, and having fun. We are learning about the sound the letter Tt makes, too!

As we learn to read, there are many common words in our language that are used frequently.

As the children encounter these "sight" or "memory" words, they are not able to sound them out according to the rules we have learned, so far. Students must memorize the letters and recognize that word by sight. Last week our class was introduced to the first of these memory words, "a". When your child is reading this word, make sure they are saying it properly using the "uh" sound (as in America, not the "short a" sound like in apple, or the "long a" sound like in apron).

Our **first graders** are starting a new reading unit and we are introducing long vowels this week. This is a really big step for our first graders because up until now we have only been using the short vowel sound as we sound out words. Any long vowel words we encountered were considered "Memory Words." Now the students will learn the second major sound that each of the vowels can make and rules about when to use a long vowel sound instead of a short vowel sound as they are reading. **Their spelling test will be on Friday, 12/13/24.**
