This week's **Bible lessons** focus on how much care and concern Jesus showed to others as he was on his way to Jerusalem to die. In our first lesson we see how Jesus showed his power over life and death as he raised Lazarus from the dead. Throughout this lesson we see just how much Jesus cares for his friends, especially as he wept at the grave of Lazarus. We can always remember that our Savior loves each of us that same way. During this unit the children will review all the Superkids and what each Superkid loves doing and practicing words with the "uh" sound.

Our **first graders** are continuing their unit about contractions this week. Our lessons will include contractions that have a "tricky" spelling.
