Hot Lunch

On Fridays, we like to offer a hot lunch to our students that is provided by parent volunteers. Our first hot lunch will **start this week** Friday, August 30th, with the school providing the meal. We have three more available dates between now and the December Christmas break, as well as 12 dates open starting in January, where **we are still in need of volunteers**. We do ask for a \$2 donation from each child for these Friday hot lunches. We are offering a new option this year where you can pay a total of \$60 for the whole year so you do not have to worry about sending \$2 each Friday. If you would choose to pay for the whole year, there would not be any reimbursements, including if your child is gone on a Friday, or there is no volunteer for hot lunch on a given Friday, or your child does not want/like the food provided that day and they bring their own lunch. If you would like to choose the new option, you may send the \$60 this coming Friday.
