### Pickup/Dropoff Instructions

In the name of safety and efficiency, please follow the following guidelines when dropping off and picking up your children.

- Always enter the parking lot (in front of the main door) through the **Church Ln** entrance, not the Church Rd entrance (please follow the yellow path in the diagram below).
- When picking up your children at 2:55, allow our two school buses to pull up to the school first. If you arrive before the buses have departed, please park in one of the RED parking sections on the map below or drive up behind the buses and wait until the buses have departed to pull up to the school doors.
- When picking up your children at **11:30 or 12:00** (3K or half-day 4K), park in any of the RED sections and meet your child at the school doors or pull up alongside the school along the YELLOW path.
